Garden Waste Collection

In our last newsletter we were pleased to inform you that we have introduced a garden waste collection service.

Garden waste that can be collected as part of this service is:

- grass, hedge and shrub cuttings
- leaves and weeds
- plants and flowers
- straw, hay and sawdust
- tree bark and small branches (less than 50mm or two inches in diameter)
- vegetarian pet waste (for example, from rabbits, guinea pigs and hamsters)

To make use of the bins, please inform Wettons that you will be leaving out garden waste for

collection. Collection happens everyTuesday, so please ensure any garden waste is ready to be collected by Wettons on Monday.
